BOAT LICENSE COURSE

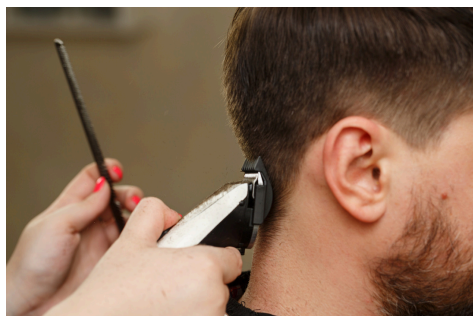
Including Jet Ski License for ages 16+

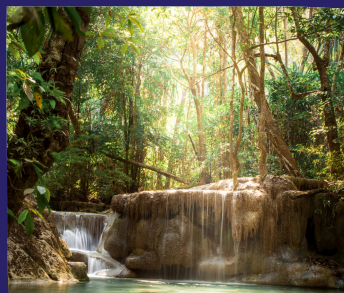
